Posting a Discussion Board

***Commonly referred to as "DB"**

- Choose your class
- Click "Discussion"
- Chose the proper DB you are lacksquaresupposed to be posting on.
- Click "Reply"
- Type your response
- Click "Post Reply"



Modules What is a Module?

- Modules are the different units associated with your class.
- Inside of the modules tab, you will find all of the assignments and links that you will need to complete assignments.
- THIS IS WHERE YOUR WORK IS
- Sometimes a module will be grayed out and you cannot access the materials in it until you complete all items from the previous module.
- If you are having a hard time moving on, go back and make sure you haven't missed something from the previous module.

Grades Please note, this is not PowerSchool.

- The grades tab is a great place to go and see what you made on your assignments, and to see if you are missing anything.
- Some teachers will not put anything into the grades section of Canvas.
- Your final grades are reported in <u>PowerSchool</u>. This is where the information reflected on your report card comes from.
- **Parents, if you do not have access to PowerSchool, I would encourage you to reach out to your schools data manager for assistance setting this up.**

Assignments Page

- Not all classes will have this tab
- If your teacher has an assignments tab, this is more than likely where you will find all of your work.
- If this tab is not being used by your teacher, stick with finding your work from the "Modules" tab.
