



Title I is a federally funded program that provides extra help for students in Reading and Math during the school day. A school is eligible to be a Title I school if it meets the required number of students receiving free or reduced lunch (this, however, has nothing to do with whether or not a child receives Title I services).

Our goal in Title I is to accelerate the learning process in order to get the students up to grade level. We do this by focusing on each individual learner and by using the most up-to-date teaching strategies. Title I staff may work with a

small group in the regular classroom setting or in a pull-out setting. We may also work one-on-one; for example, with reading conferencing or math



tutoring. A student is identified needing extra help through a variety of assessments -- giving the teachers an accurate idea of a student's strengths and weaknesses.

The Title I Program offers assistance to parents in the form of workshops throughout the school year. The workshops provide valuable information for parents to help them with promoting and encouraging their child's education.
